CCG Shutdown

Please be aware the next CCG Shutdown date is Tuesday 24th November 2020 from 12.00 noon. The Mid-Essex CCG will be providing out-of-hours care for our patients from 12.00 noon until 18.30 pm and our telephone lines will be diverted to the care provider during this time. In the case of urgent need whilst the practice is closed you can call NHS 111 to speak to a triage nurse. Your needs will be assessed and advice offered or arrangements made for you to see a doctor. Out-of-hours services are generally busy so please think carefully before asking to see a doctor and only do so if you genuinely cannot wait until the surgery re-opens. In a genuine emergency you should call 999. Chest pains and/or shortness of breath constitute an emergency. Hours will resume as normal on Wednesday 25th November 2020.

Patient Reminder

We are continuing to keep footfall into the surgery at a minimum and asking patients to adhere to the social distancing and one in one out rules. In order to help this we have now installed a traffic light system at the front door at Danbury Medical Centre, which is now the entrance for prescription collection only. Please only enter the surgery when the light is green.

For pre-booked appointments or collection please follow the signs to the side entrance at Danbury Medical Centre.

This can result in patients having to queue outside of the surgery therefore can we ask that patients dress appropriately for the weather especially coming into the winter months.
