Covid-19 Vaccinations

We are continuing to offer our patients across all three surgeries the Covid-19 vaccination at Danbury Medical Centre.

We are following the Public Health England guidance and offering the vaccine to patients in cohorts. We are texting and calling patients to book these appointments.

Please do not call or email the surgery to book.

Some patients have already received letters and texts to book in for both their vaccines at alternative locations. Please note wherever you choose to have your first vaccination you must also have the second vaccination with the same provider. The surgery has no knowledge of the information regarding other vaccination centres.

Carer

If you are a carer and this is not recorded on your patient record please visit our website to complete the Carers Form under the 'Register Now' tab.

A carer is someone who, without payment, provides care and support to a relative, partner or friend who cannot manage without your help. It is important that you visit your doctor regularly and that you tell your doctor that you are in a caring role.

CCG Shutdown

Please be aware the next CCG Shutdown date is Wednesday 31st March 2021 from 12.00 noon. The Mid-Essex CCG will be providing out-of-hours care for our patients from 12.00 noon until 18.30 pm and our telephone lines will be diverted to the care provider during this time. In the case of urgent need whilst the practice is closed you can call NHS 111 to speak to a triage nurse. Your needs will be assessed and advice offered or arrangements made for you to see a doctor. Out-of-hours services are generally busy so please think carefully before asking to see a doctor and only do so if you genuinely cannot wait until the surgery re-opens. In a genuine emergency you should call 999. Chest pains and/or shortness of breath constitute an emergency. Hours will resume as normal on Thursday 1st April 2021.

Due to this date being close to the bank holiday weekend the dispensary will remain open for prescription collection only.
