In the case of urgent need whilst the practice is closed you can call **NHS 111** to speak to a triage nurse. Your needs will be assessed and advice offered or arrangements made for you to see a doctor. Out-of-hours services are generally busy so please think carefully before asking to see a doctor and only do so if you genuinely cannot wait until the surgery re-opens.

In a genuine emergency you should call 999. Chest pains and / or shortness of breath constitute an emergency.

Alternatively, if you have an already have an appointment booked you can ask for the flu vaccine to be administered during your existing appointment. Please just ask your clinician or speak to reception.

Warning - Flu Vaccine Scam

Please note there is currently a flu vaccine scam being carried out in the local area in regards to asking for payment for the vaccine. The Beacon Health Group will not call you to tell you we cannot provide your flu vaccine unless you pay. Those eligible for the vaccine do not have to pay for it. If you are called by anyone please notify the police immediately. Do not give your bank details to anyone over the phone.

Push Doctor

The Beacon Health Group is thrilled to announce 'Push Doctor' a new service offering digital appointments with NHS-trained UK GPs over face to face video call.

If your concern is deemed suitable we will send out an invitation for the service which will ask you to register online or download the app. This will enable you to book 'Push Doctor' appointments and have your consultation digitally via video on your smart phone, tablet or computer. Push Doctor will be able to access your medical record for the duration of the consultation and just like in a traditional GP appointment, you will discuss your symptoms, medical history and any other details you want to make the doctor aware of. This is all completely private and confidential, just as it would be within the surgery.

DNA's

The Beacon Health Group has sadly had an alarming number of DNA's reported for the month of September 2019. A total of 487 patients did not attend their appointments. This averages approx. 23 appointments a day. Please remember to cancel an appointment by phone or text message if it is no longer needed to allow other patients the opportunity of using the appointment.

Dispensary Update

In order to reduce wastage, stock piling and improve overall patient safety The Beacon Health Group will no longer accept repeat prescription requests from any community or online pharmacies as of 1st October 2019 for example 'Pharmacy2U'. We would like patients to order their own medication directly from the surgery and would encourage patients to use our online services or electronic repeat dispensing where possible.

Please note the dispensary will aim to have your prescription ready within 48 hours however please check with your individual pharmacy for a timeframe on your items being dispensed.

Just to remind all patients that there is a post box outside of all three surgeries for repeat prescription requests. You do not need to queue up at reception/dispensary to hand these in.
